

I, Charles Veley, Founder and Chairman of Most Traveled People, reviewed Nina Sedano's travel documentation in person in Frankfurt, Germany on July 18-19, 2023. Nina's 11 passports, documentation, photographs and journals reflect that she went to the 193 UN countries by September 23, 2011.

In addition to the 193 UN Countries that Nina Sedano visited by 2011, she went to the UN Observer States within the same time period: Palestine in April 2008 and Vatican City in December 1987; She also visited the UN non-member states of Taiwan in November 2002 and Kosovo in March 2008. Besides these 197 main building blocks which many travelers use to start their “country-counting” journeys, Nina has also visited a large number of dependencies and overseas territories around the world.

Nina Sedano has documented proof of her travels to every UN member nation and observer state by 2011. Her documentation also reflects that she traveled in depth, spending quality time in each location rather than merely crossing a border in order to check a list and quickly cross back.

Finally, Nina Sedano has actually visited the UN member nations of North Korea and Syria. She obtained visas and proceeded legally through immigration into those countries, rather than avoiding interaction with the countries by simply standing within the DMZ from the South Korean side, or within the Golan Heights from the Israeli side.
